
Chuck Close Inspired Portrait



Chuck Close Self-Portrait

Create a portrait using the same grid method technique of Chuck Close. You will decide on orientation, shapes, colors, and digital painting technique.

Finished Project Requirements:

- □ Use portrait as the basis for your design
- □ In Photoshop, File > Open your photograph
- Image > Image Size Alter your document to a minimum of 8.5 by 11 inches
- Set up a Grid:
 View > Show > Grid
 Photoshop > Preferences > Guides, Grid, & Slices
 Grid needs to be at least ½ inch in diameter.

- Demonstrates creativity and experimentation while using an assortment of digital painting techniques. Some options to consider:
 - Square Brush (Located in your Brush Options)
 - Edit > Fill within a selected square
 - Image > Adjustments within a selected square
 - Mixer Brush
 - Blur Tool & Smudge Tool within a selected square
 - Opacity
 - Duplicate with Move Tool
- Two files need to be submitted to your Google Drive Folder PSD & JPEG
